TAM is the system of record for job recruitments and applicant-tracking for staff (non-students)

TAM or Template?

TAM - PREPARE FOR HIRE (PFH) For simple recruited hiring scenarios

- Employees with no previous UC employment
- Employees with no more than 1 existing UCSB job record (active or inactive)

TEMPLATE BASED HIRE (TBH) For more complex hiring scenarios

- Employees with multiple job records
- Transactions involving non-UCSB job records
- Academic hires
- Student hires
- Limited hires 'not recruited through TAM'
